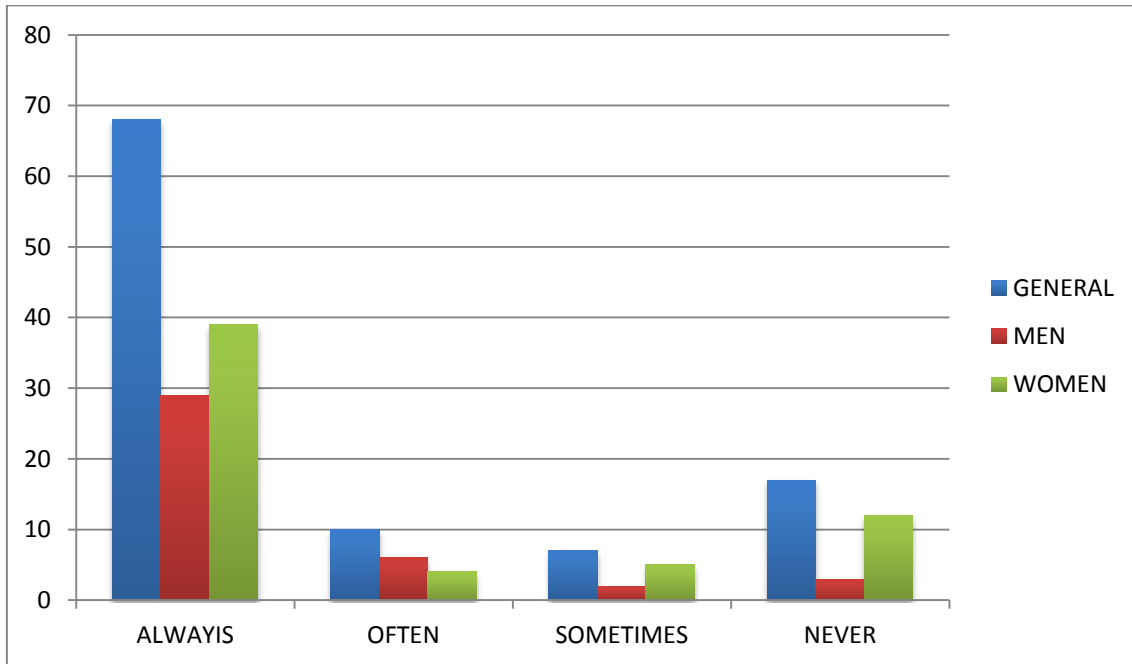

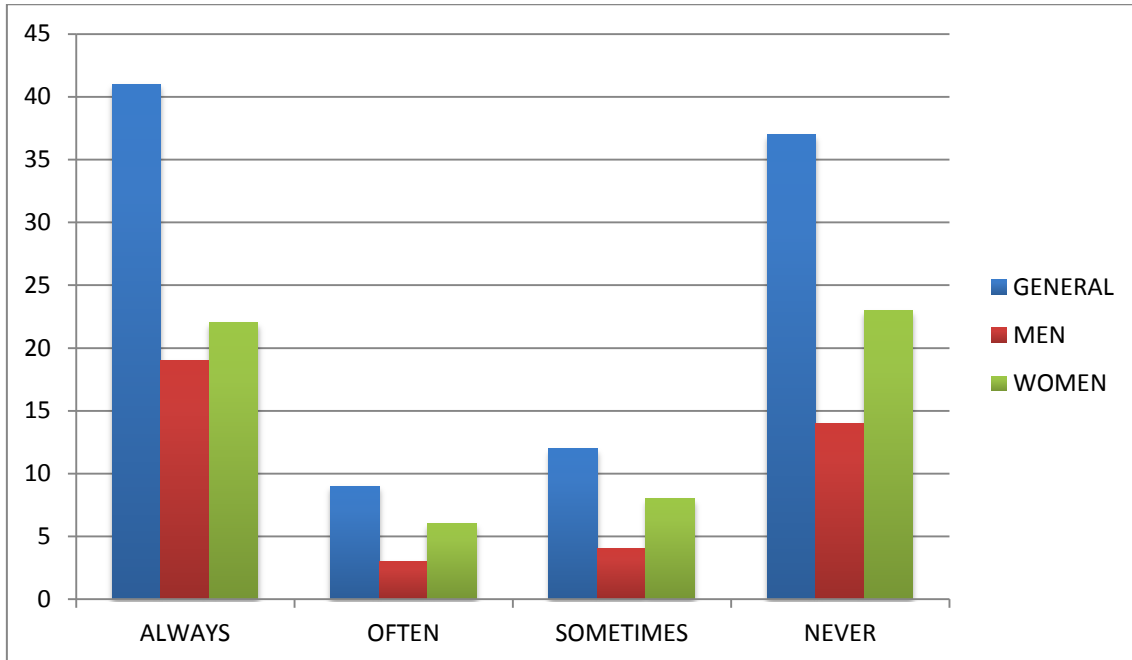

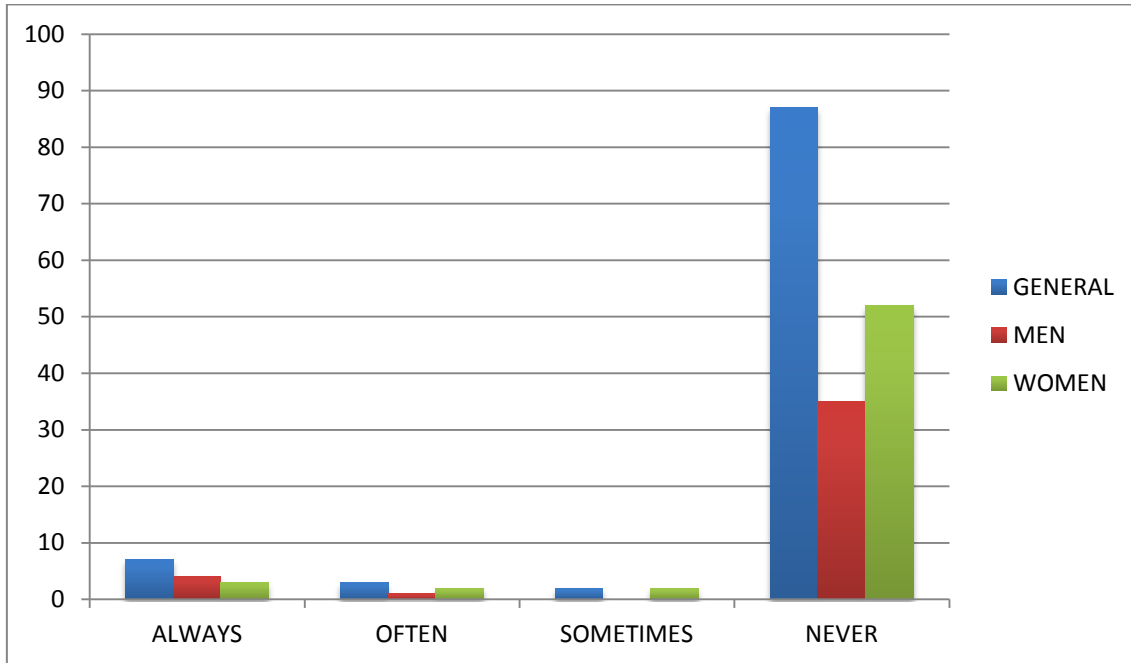
1. Do you think that boys and girls have the same opportunities to study in our country?



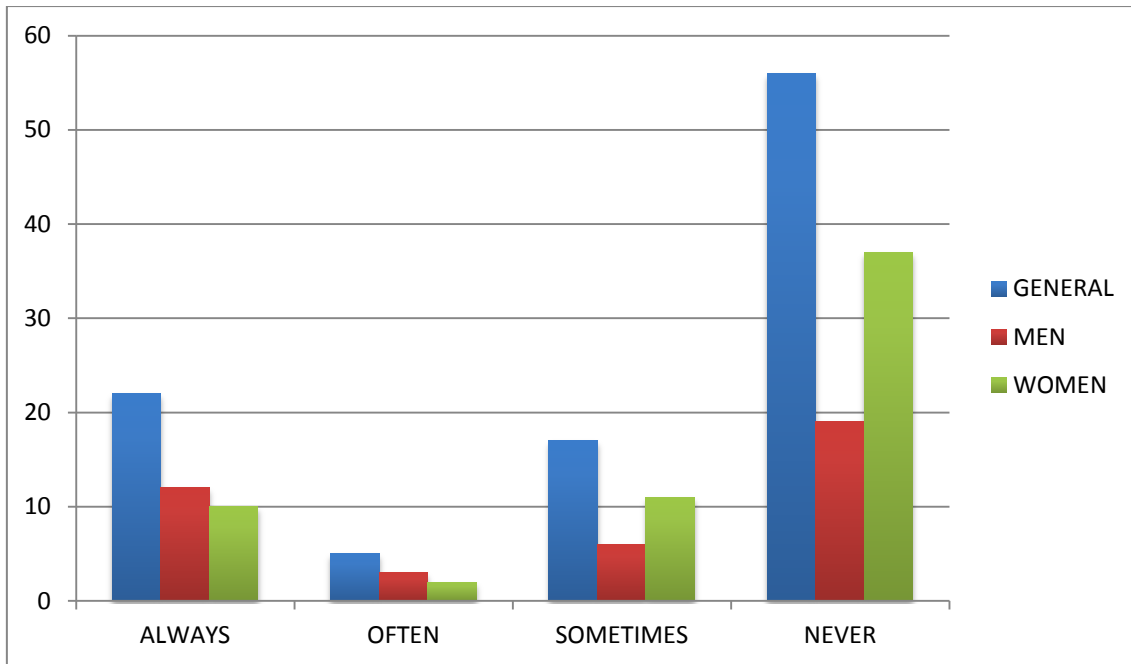

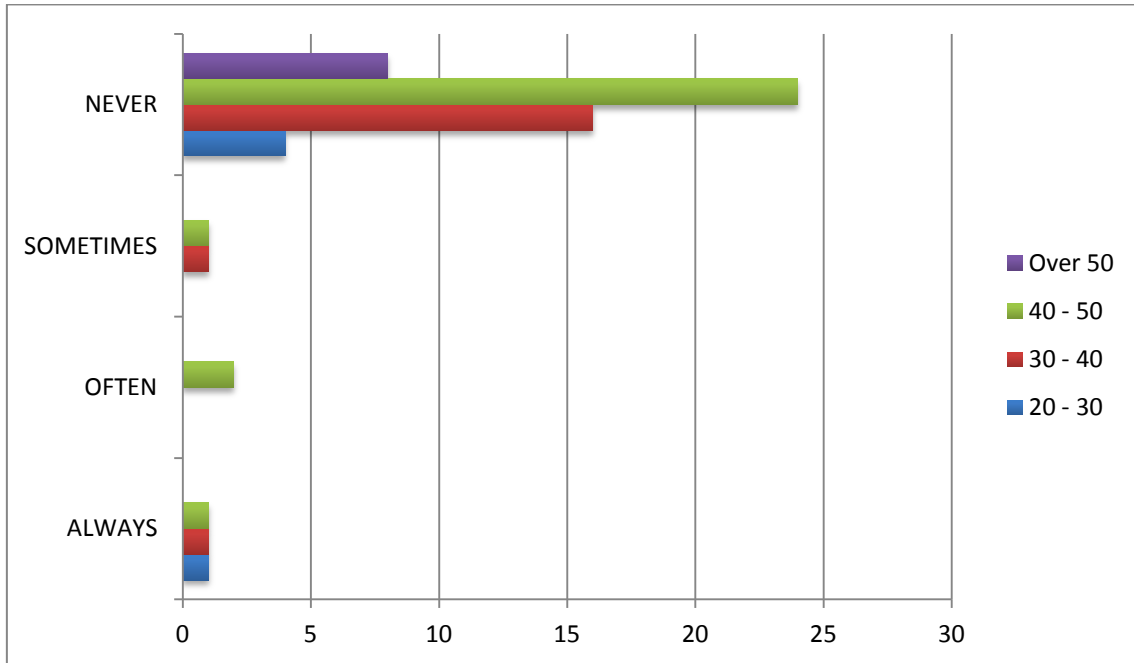

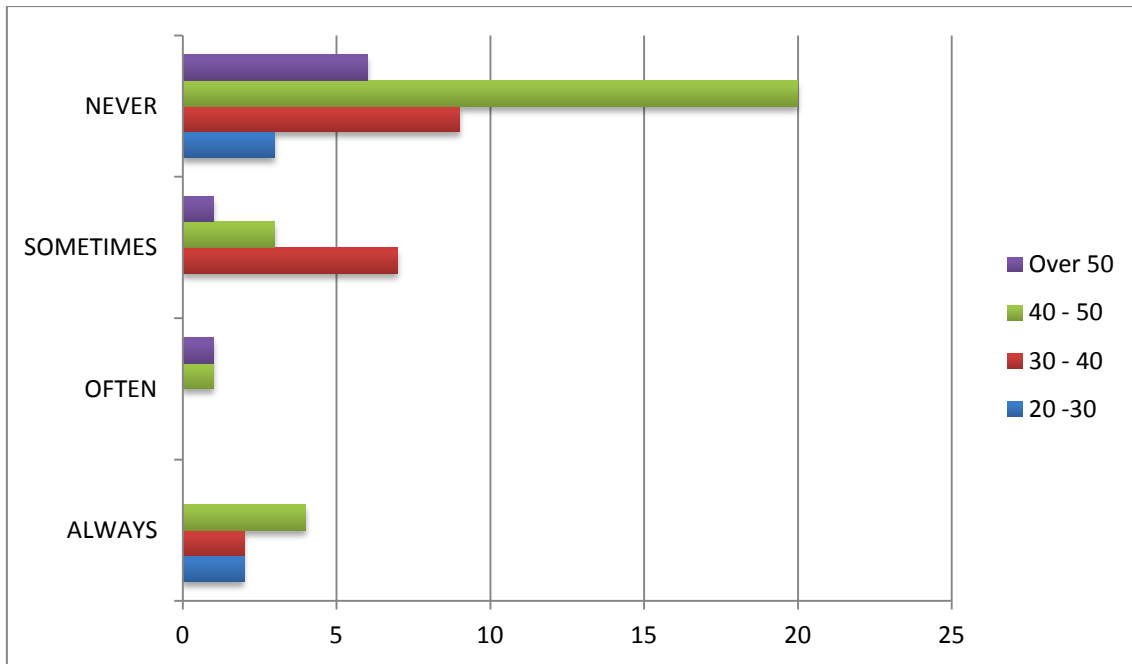

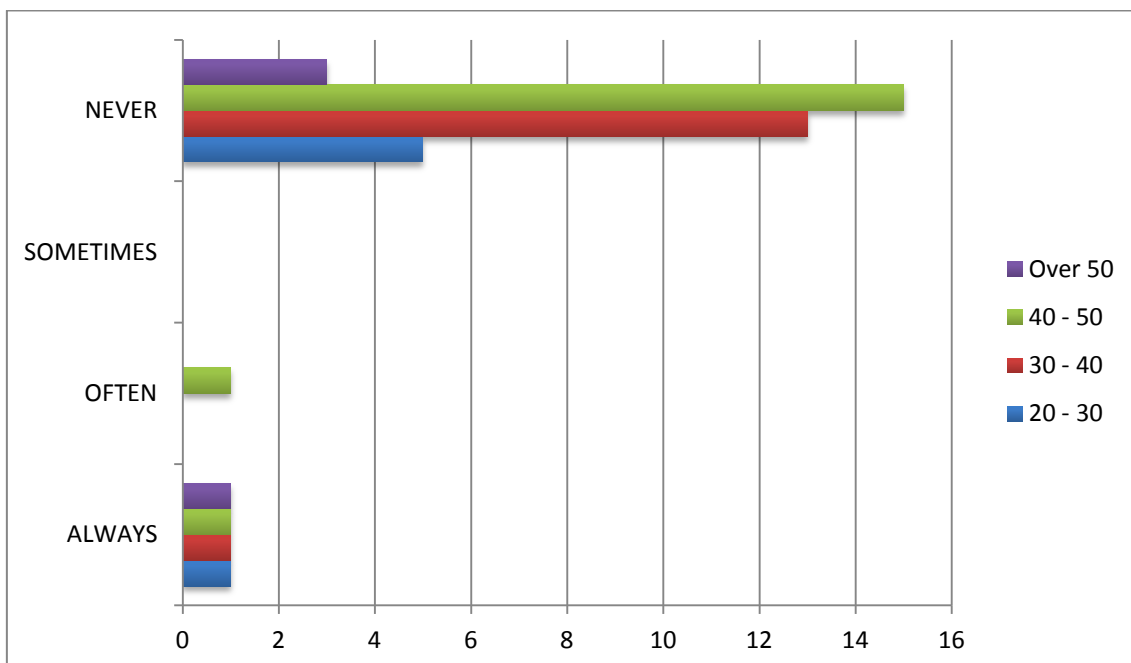

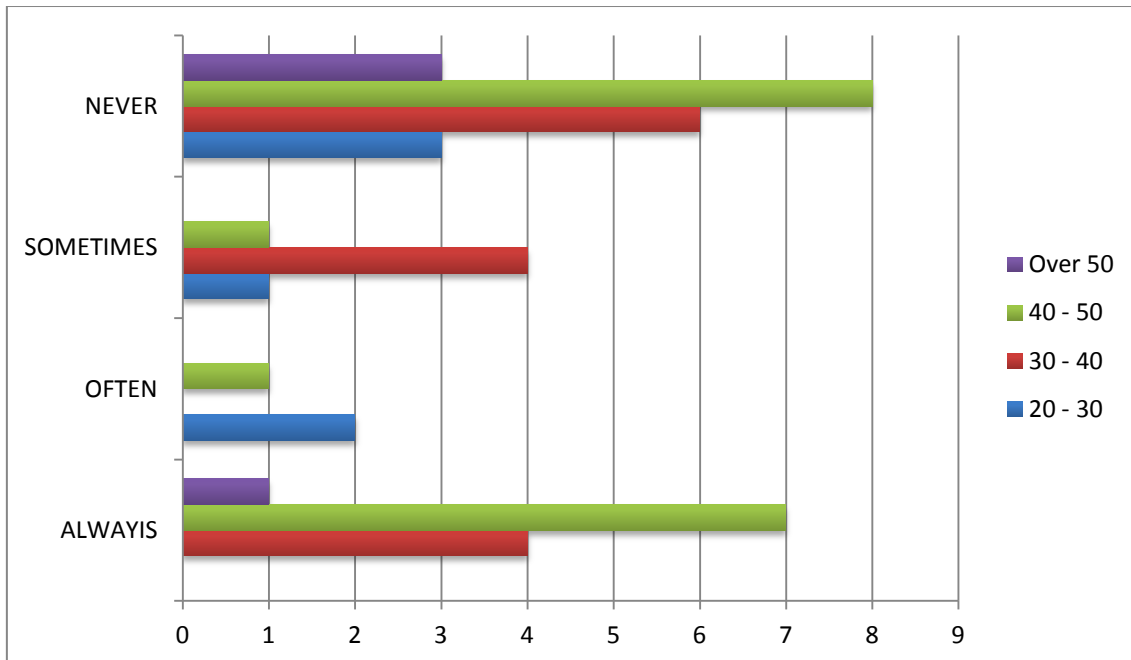

Survey made by students of C. E. S. "San Juan Bosco-Salesian School", Los Dolores, Cartagena.

The survey was made to 100 people living in Los Dolores, of both genders, over 18 years old and with different level of education.

The results show that most respondents believe that they have the same opportunities to access education, at different levels, in our country, although, as shown in the graphs there are subjects and / or degrees that are considered more appropriate depending on the gender.

About the opportunities to start to work , the survey shows that in general it is believed that there is not equal opportunity between men and women to find a job, being higher the percentage of women who share this view.



In short, the results show that although in academic studies discrimination by gender is hardly perceived, this trend changes dramatically when entering the world of work.
